A San Diego-based organization established to prevent the spread of AIDS/HIV infection. The objective of the organization is to provide AIDS/HIV counseling, intervention and referral services to the Latino/a community with special emphasis for Spanish monolingual individuals.”

“PACTO—the name, though all in capitals, is not an acronym—is an AIDS organization aimed specifically at Latinos and Latinas who speak Spanish only (though their quarterly newsletter is bilingual). It provides mental health outreach, as well as prevention and education services, and has no eligibility criteria other than a knowledge of Spanish. According to founding chair Marco Flores, PACTO has a budget of \$28,000 to \$30,000 per year, no full-time paid staff three ‘stipend positions’ (ie. paid a token amount only) and 58 volunteers. PACTO also operates an AIDS residence, Casa del Sol, in City Heights. PACTO’s office is at 3766 Fifth Avenue in the Davids’ Place building in Hillcrest.”
