PROCESSING INFORMATION

This collection was processed by Gabrielle Garcia as part of the 2020 CSL Project. This project was guided by an overarching anti-racist framework that informs archival practice in all aspects at Lambda Archives. Therefore, along with processing the collections specified in the original narrative, we intentionally prioritize the collections of BIPOC and Transgender members of the community to preserve and disseminate their narratives, which have been historically ignored and suppressed in archives across the U.S.

This framework promotes transparency and accountability in our responsibility to those in the LGBTQ+ community that have been historically underrepresented, misrepresented and/or trivialized in archives. Our goals are to (a) gain or rebuild trust with BIPOC members of the community; (b) more fully reflect the community's diversity; (c) outwardly recognize the contributions that BIPOC have made which have enabled the community, as a whole, to flourish; and (d) improve the discoverability of these under-acknowledged histories to increase their engagement for varying purposes within the community and for research and public knowledge.

BIOGRAPHY OR HISTORY

Ayari Aguayo is an undergraduate from San Diego State University who majored in Women's Studies. She was a member of the Gamma Rho Lambda, a LGBTQ sorority. In 2008 she worked on the Decline to Sign and No on Prop efforts as a Senior Field Organizer for the Equality for All Campaign in support of same-sex marriage. Since then,

she received her master's degree in Sustainable International Development (S.I.D.) from Brandeis. Aguayo now works as the Director of Communications & Social Responsibility at Honey Shine Inc., a non-profit in South Florida uplifting and empowering girls and young women.
